

INTERNATIONAL YOUNG ARCHITECTS' AWARDS AND EXHIBITION

“TEMPORARY SHELTERING SPACES”

THE AIM AND EXTENT

The era we are in, is the stage to the most rapid population growth in history. Parallel to this growth; the duty of responding to spatial needs of disaster victims or refugees due to man-made disasters or natural such as earthquake, flood, fire, war, famine and poverty; has become more difficult. Disaster victims and refugees represent the masses, which are left out of the privileged classes of the societies, and thus which are disadvantaged in reaching to architectural services. Hence, within the context of above-mentioned disasters; the responsibilities of architects and the position of the profession is subject to question and open to debate.

The monumental and prestigious examples of architecture come forth today as they have in the history. The spatial needs and problems of those who represent the everyday and "ordinary" life have usually been disregarded. As an universal discipline, architecture bears the responsibility of providing the sheltering needs of those who have unique cultural and functional conditions around the world. Thus, the disasters mentioned at the beginning, bring major potential and opportunities for the inquiry of ethic values fundamental to the profession.

The main aim of the Event is to evaluate the architectural responses to the needs of temporary housing and open them to debate. Furthermore, the provision of temporary housing needs of disaster victims is expected to be considered as a spatial configuration and a stage for examining the current developments in material and structural systems. Thereof, the temporary housing settlements – which came forth as a result of disasters – are expected to produce the outcome of increase in the quality of architectural design. The participants of the competition are required to define a context of a disaster of their choice, to produce demountable design proposals for temporary housing units and settlements in an economic and practical way. Both visual and textual formats are going to be used for the presentation of the design proposals.

ORGANIZERS

The event is organized by the Chamber of Architects of Turkey hosted by Antalya Branch under the auspices of UIA.

TYPE OF THE EVENT

This single stage ideas awards programme is open to young architects worldwide in accordance with UIA-UNESCO regulations.

TERMS FOR PARTICIPATION

- To be born after 1974 and to be an architect,
- To be a member of the Chamber of Architects of Turkey for participants from Turkey,
- To be a member of an organization of architects in their own country for the participants from abroad.
- It is possible to participate as a team. Each member of the team has to fulfill the above mentioned conditions.

- Participation in the event is free of charge.
- People who are relatives of jurors or the Technical Committee can not participate in the event.

LANGUAGE OF THE EVENT

Turkish and English are the official languages for projects and documents.

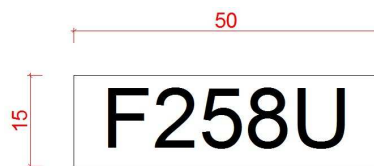
QUESTIONS&ANSWERS

All questions about the event will be asked by using the question-answer form on the web site up to 17 December 2012.

Questions will be answered by the organizers of the competition up to 28 December 2012 All questions and answers will be published on the Young Architects' Meeting web site on that date.

ANONYMITY

- All projects will be presented and adjudicated anonymously. Participants will chose an identity code that will appear on each document submitted. This code will be made up of 3 numbers (non-consecutive) and 2 letters. They will be written on the 15mm/50mm white background with black letters and it will be written on right upper corner of the all documents making up the entry.



- The technical committee will mask these identity codes with a serial number for the duration of the jury meeting.
- When the jury has made it final selection, the identification envelopes will be opened and anonymity lifted.

SUBMISSION OF THE PROJECT

- Entries will be submitted anonymously.
- Submissions will include a sealed envelope containing the competitors personal information. The identity code of the participants will be written on the outside the of envelope in which applicants' name, surname, telephone number, e-mail address, communication address, photocopy of their identity card/passport and their registration number at their Chamber/Institute will be clearly written.
- In case of team participation, all team members' information will be in this closed identity envelope.
- Project boards will be prepared according to the template. The template can be found on website. The Project boards (70cm x 100 cm) will be submitted DIGITALLY without printing, at least 150dpi resolution, CMYK format, TIFF/JPEG/EPS type document recorded in DVD/CD.
- DVD/CD and identity envelopes will be packed in paper on which “**INTERNATIONAL YOUNG ARCHITECTS' IDEAS AWARDS AND EXHIBITION**” is written clearly, will be sent or delivered to the address below:

- For the projects submitted from abroad, a maximum of 7 days will be allowed for delivery after the submission deadline. For the projects from Turkey it is limited to 3 days after the deadline for submission.
- The receipts and the confirmation of the carrier company about the posting date of projects should be faxed to the awards secretariat and should confirm that the projects are posted at latest on submission date March 15, 2013 at 17.00.

- The carrier service cost will be paid by the participant.
- Personally submitted projects have to be submitted by March 15, 2013, 17.00 at the latest.
- Applications which are not received on time will not be accepted.

PRESENTATION REQUIREMENT

- Project scenario will be sent in written format with maximum 500 words
- The project will be presented vertically on one sheet with dimensions 70cmx100cm.
- All documents will also be delivered on a DVD/ CD with at least 300 dpi resolution as PDF. The scenario must also be in that DVD/CD as a word document.
- Presentation technique is free.
- Each participant can present only one project.
- The identity code must be placed on right upper corner of all documents.
