These Olympiads are a confrontation of projects by high-school students in Korea and Singapore organised annually by the Federation of Institutes of Korean Architects (FIKA), with the University of Hanyang's school of architecture and engineering (Korea) and the National University of Singapore (NUS). In this year's Olympiad participants were asked to create an architectural project on the theme of speed and slowness. An excerpt from Milan Kundera's book "Slowness" was provided as a source of inspiration and reflection. The participants had to express their ideas in the form of architectural models.

### **ARCHITECTURE & CHILDREN GOLDEN CUBE AWARDS**


Last April the international jury met in Paris to select the winners of the UIA Architecture and children Golden Cube awards in four categories: schools, institutions, printed media and audiovisual media.
